<u>Cruciform 2:</u> Remember the Priest who passed by; he might have been scared.


<u>Week 2:</u> God, give me courage when I'm afraid (*Courage...*)

<u>Cruciform 3:</u> Remember the Levite who passed by; he might have been in a hurry

Week 3: God give me patience when I'm in a hurry (*Patience...*)

<u>Cruciform 4:</u> Remember the Samaritan who helped a stranger in need.

<u>Week 4:</u> God help me love all—strangers and friends (*Love...*)

**Invitatory:** God creates life. Life beholds beauty. Beauty begets love. Love is the life of God.

<u>Cruciform 1:</u> Remember the sower who went out to sow, and some seeds fell along the path and the birds ate the seeds...

**Week 1:** God, plant your love deep in me. (*Deep...*)

<u>Cruciform 2:</u> Remember the seeds that fell among stones, and the seeds could not take root, and the sun scorched the plants.

Week 2: God, let your love take root in me (Root...)




Remember the seeds that fell among the thorns, and the thorns choked the plants.

<u>Week 3:</u> God, make space for your love in me (*Space...*)

<u>Cruciform 2:</u> Remember the mustard seed being planted in the ground


**Week 2:** God, help me to trust in your plan and your power (*Trust...*)


<u>Cruciform 3:</u> Remember the tiny seed growing and growing until it was like a tree

### Praying the Parable of the Good Shepherd

<u>Cross:</u> We pray to God, the One who creates, the One who befriends, the one who inspires; Who holds us close wherever we go, whatever we do, who's holding us now.

**Invitatory:** The Lord is my shepherd I'll walk with him always. (2x) Always, always, I'll walk with him always. (2x)

<u>Cruciform 1:</u> Remember the Good Shepherd, who shows the way to the good green grass.

**Week 1:** Pray for the hungry; O God, feed them. (*Feed...*)

<u>Cruciform 2:</u> Remember the Good Shepherd, who shows the way to the cool, fresh, water.


**Week 2:** Pray for the thirsty, the tired, the weary; 0 God, refresh them. (*Refresh...*)

<u>Cruciform 3:</u> Remember the Good Shepherd, who leads the sheep safely through places of danger.


**Week 3:** Pray for the lost, the afraid, and those in need of guidance; O God, lead them (*Lead...*)

<u>Cruciform 1:</u> Remember the merchant who went out in search of the great pearl...

**Week 1:** Pray for those who are searching; (Searching...)

<u>Cruciform 2:</u> Remember how at last the merchant found the great pearl...how he must have rejoiced!

**Week 2:** Pray for those who rejoice (*Rejoicing...*)

Four cruciform Beads

Pray moving around the circle to the right

<u>Cruciform 3:</u> Remember how the merchant let go of everything he had...

Week 3: Pray for those who are letting go (*Letting go...*)

<u>Cruciform 4:</u> Remember how the merchant exchanged everything he had for the great pearl

Week 4: Pray that all might discover and treasure what is truly precious in life (*Treasure...*)
